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Looking at Overvecht – Other ways of Picturing the Post-War Housing Estate

Renée Kool and Neeltje ten Westenend

At the invitation of the Municipality of Utrecht, the visual artist <u>Renée Kool</u> and the designer <u>Neeltje ten</u> <u>Westenend</u>, in collaboration with <u>Henriette Waal</u>, undertook an exploration of the *genius loci* of Overvecht. Their quest resulted in two film works which – each in its own way – shed a new light on this post-war housing estate: *Perfect Day* (Neeltje Westenend) and *Overvecht Between About '64 and '76* (Renée Kool). This book, containing a DVD of both works, examines the underlying ideas, the research and the methods adopted.

Through the ways in which they have pictured Overvecht, Ten Westenend and Kool have made a fresh contribution to the discussion about the value of post-war housing estates and their possibilities for redevelopment.
