Disorderly Group Behavior in Public Space

The participants of the *Disorderly Group Behavior in Public Space* research group based in Amsterdam present the first results in an open forum to discuss various issues that surround public space, architecture, and social psychology.

In our daily lives, we are regularly confronted with situations that could be described as 'disorderly group behavior in public space'. Many situations can easily be imagined, but also raise questions: What do we mean with the terms 'disorder', 'group' and 'public space'? And what conditions influence these situations?

Over the course of 2014, a research group initiated by architectural designer Elmo Vermijs focused on this topic – aiming to connect and research the architectural and social psychological aspects. Several experts from both disciplines were consulted, and a wide range of issues where discussed, such as: performativity, acting, unpredictability, (social) media, democracy, crowd control, individuality, public sphere, and semi-public space.

As an attempt to understand as well as question these situations we kindly invite you to our public event, which will dive deeper into the topic of disorderly group behavior. The evening consists of a presentation of short case studies, a (theoretical) diagram, and questions as well as tentative results from the researchers individual projects. This will show the extent of the research and act as a starting point from which the relation and boundaries between architecture and social psychology are brought into question.

With insights from special guests Professor Lara Schrijver and Assistant Professor Daniel Lakens, we welcome your thoughts and encourage conversation.
