

Creator Doctus: Documentation Yael Davids & start of the second trajectory with Femke Herregraven

On 28th of September 2020 Yael Davids publicly defended her research concluding the first Creator Doctus (CrD) trajectory. **She was awarded the first CrD degree!**

The focus of Yael Davids' research A Daily Practice is on somatic learning and consists of three phases. The research, supervised by the Van Abbemuseum and the Gerrit Rietveld Academie, is inspired by the work of Dr. Noshe Feldenkrais. Feldenkrais developed a ne hed for people to change bodily habits from within. This rethod has played an important role in Davics' riists, practice in the last years.


